



Hawks Prairie Rotary Annual Charity Golf Tournament

GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES: (all golf rules shall conform to USGA Rules)

FORMAT: 18 hole Tournament - four-person scramble tournament

RULES: All rules interpretations will be handled and resolved by the Tournament Competition Committee.

1. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
4. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score. For instance, if a player taps their 2nd putt in before all other players have taken their first putt, the score is counted as two putts even if the next player makes their first putt.
5. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away. In the event a ball must be played from a sand trap, the area may be raked between shots; however, the original lie must be simulated and the ball placed in a similar manner.
6. Each team must use at least one of each team members tee shots on each nine (minimum two shots per player).
7. Men tee off from the white tees and women from the red tees.
8. Mulligans are available from the tournament sponsor for \$5 each. There is no limit on the number of mulligan's a player may purchase; however, mulligans must be purchased before the round begins in order to be used during the round. Mulligans may be used at any time during the round except that shots played using a mulligan do not qualify for Hole in One, closest-to-the-hole and longest drive prizes.
9. Ties will be broken by a match of scorecards starting with the # 1 handicap hole.

GOLF ETIQUETTE:

1. Please smooth all marks made in Sand Bunkers.
2. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
3. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
4. Balls may be cleaned on the green and ball marks should be repaired prior to putting.
5. Please observe all local course rules.
6. Enjoy the day and your friendships with other Rotarian golfers!
7. Appropriate golf tournament attire is required. This includes shirts with collars and sleeves. Shorts must be "Bermuda" length, no denim or casual fleece-style sweats. Soft spikes only.

Fun is mandatory: anyone caught being too competitive will be assessed a two-stroke penalty!

CONTESTS:

Closest to the Pin: This competition for men (Hole #3) and for women (Hole #13). If your tee shot is closest to the Pin/Hole, write your name on the marker card and place the marker in the ground on the spot where your ball came to rest. Once the marker has been placed in the ground, it should stay there until someone else hits a closer shot. Use the tape measure provided. Then, that person should repeat the procedure of writing their name on the card below the other name(s) and place the marker at the spot.

Longest Drive: This competition for men (Hole #18) and for Women (Hole #14). If your drive is the longest and over 150 yards in length, write your name on the marker card and place the marker in the ground on the spot where your ball lays. Once the marker has been placed in the ground, it should stay there until someone else makes a drive longer than yours. Then, that person should repeat the procedure of writing their name on the card below the other name(s) and place the marker at the spot.

Hole in One: This is an individual competition (Holes #3, #6, #13, #16). Each player has the opportunity to hit a Hole in One at the designated holes and win the prize for that hole. Mulligans do not qualify.

"Hawks Prairie Golf Club requires that we meet their standard pace of play, which is approximately 4 hours 30 minutes. If a group is classified as out of position, the course assistant may ask that group to skip a hole to get back into position. Please record par for the skipped hole."
