Next are Mike and Julie Ernesti on Piano and Drums. They are a superbly talented duo that have led their own bands and also toured the world with the USO for years. Julie's powerhouse vocals and Mike's spontaneous bursts of levity are much requested on the jazz festival circuit.

On Bass and Vocals is the highly esteemed Hal Champ, who performed for 45 years with Stan Boreson, and has the finest tenor voice you've ever heard. At the age of 83, Hal is also one of the busiest musicians.

Filing the demanding Banjo position is Dale Brown. Dale brings his talents as a writer and “Barber Shop” singer to the group.
